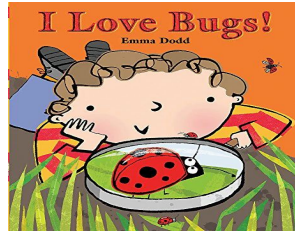


Science - In science, the next half term we will be focusing on vertebrates. We will be studying each animal group and looking at the features that link them to that group. We will also be exploring which animals are carnivores, omnivores and herbivores and what this means. We will compare what their eggs are like, what they eat and how they breathe.

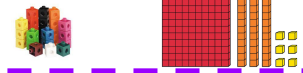
English - For the first 3 weeks we will have a look at our first non-fiction book called 'A day at the zoo', where the children will look at sequencing a story about a family's trip to the zoo. They will then use the structure of this story to write about their own trip to a place of their choosing.



In the final weeks the children will be going back to poetry with the book 'I love bugs'. The children will look at rhyming words and will have a go at creating their own poems about a topic of their choosing.

Maths - We will be using the Power Maths scheme of work, alongside White Rose resources to teach the children about subtraction and addition. We will be using a variety of practical resources to help with our learning.

Computing - In computing, we will discuss about digital images. The children will sequence images into the correct order, take photos and edit them, search for images on a computer and print them to put into a collage.

PE - will be every Monday and Tuesday for Yr1/2. Please can you ensure your child wears a PE Kit to school on those days.

RE - In RE, we will be asking the question 'Who do Christians say made the world?' We will look at religious stories and gather the children's views and opinions.

History -

During this term, the children will begin to learn about the life of a person living through the effects of Pompeii. We will learn how life in Italy has changed since the events of Pompeii, how we know so much about the event through the findings of archaeologists and what cause the Roman empire had on the rest of the world.



Music - In our weekly sessions the children will be introducing the instruments of the orchestra and learning how different characters can be represented by timbre, how emotions can be represented by pitch and how changes in tempo can convey action.

Art - In Art, we will be learning about weaving. We will create a woven piece of Art and have a look at Artists. We will also have a look at what Art is and if we can define it. We will explore threading and knotting techniques with a variety of materials.

PSHE - In PSHE we are going to be looking into 'Citizenship'. We will consider rules, similarities and differences, how to look after a pet and democracy. School council members will be explaining their roles to the children.



Read Write Inc - The children will continue to have daily RWi lessons in school. The children will take home an AR/colour banded book as well as RWi book bag book to support their reading from home.
