Maths: This term we will be continuing with multiplication and division. The children will be expected to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. Please can children use Times Table Rock Stars weekly and complete their mymaths homework fortnightly.







Science: Our science unit is called The Power of Forces. During this unit of work, we will be looking at the term force as well as exploring magnets and their uses. Children will carry out a range of investigations to help them with their learning and to encourage them to see themselves as scientists.




