

Maths: In maths this term we start to look at measure, ratio and proportion and algebra. The pupils will apply their new knowledge in a range of different contexts.

Guided reading:
This half term we will be focussing on the book 'Wonder' by R.J.Palacio.




English: During this term, the children will be writing instructions using the text 'Survival Handbook: Jungle' as a stimulus. We will also be creating our own narrative based on the story 'Beowulf.'
